I. Internal review meetings on results

TSM reviews the effectiveness of the teaching-learning process through Instructors Meeting, Programme Execution Meeting (PEC), and Faculty Council Meeting for each trimester and performs result analysis and identify remedial measures.

The Programme level outcomes (80% is direct assessment and 20% is indirect assessment) is quantified in 1 to 3 scale and is measure in the following way, (PO1-PO5)

- POBE score = 1, if 60% of students got 60 % of trimester's OBE score
- POBE score = 2, if 70% of students got 60% of trimester's OBE score
- POBE score = 3, if 80% of students got 60 % of trimester's OBE score


