## A Brief Report on Faculty Retreat to Thekkady

## 29-31 May 2022

TSM conducts an Annual Faculty Planning Meeting every year to discuss the completed academic year proceedings and plan for the upcoming academic year. This year, in addition to the plans for the next academic year, the team discussed the road map for the next five years. The Faculty Members and their Family Members went for a Faculty Retreat to Thekkady during 29-31 May 2022. Around 26 Faculty Members participated in this trip.

The trip aimed at providing a new setup to introspect of what had happened in the last 2021-2022 and to deliberate on what could be the way forward, both in the next academic year and in the next five years. The trip facilitated to get fresh ideas in all the critical domains.

Dr. Murali Sambasivan, Director, TSM, presented his three-year strategic rolling plan for TSM to all the TSM Faculty members. The family members also participated in this session and were excited by the growth path presented by the Director. In addition, the Family members appreciated the commitment of top Management in the institution's growth.

Dr. Vignesh and Team presented the placement proceedings and the areas of improvement. The faculty council appreciated the Placement Team for achieving the current year Final Placement average CTC is Rs.6.95 lakhs, which is a good improvement compared with the previous years. However, all the Faculty Members are unanimous that TSM's average placement salary to be increased significantly. The Faculty Council suggested identifying the recruiters in Mumbai, Delhi NCR regions, organizing Recruiters Conclave, conducting competency skill mapping of all the students etc.

Dr. Manjula presented the admissions proceedings. The faculty members pondered how to increase the diversity of other states students and increase the CAT/MAT students than TANCET students.

Dr. Wajahat, a member of the Certifications Committee, presented the possible certification programmes which could be offered in the upcoming academic year. The committee received suggestions including possible tie-ups with CII, NSE, and reputed organisations in offering joint certification programmes. Exploring the chances of collaboration with Online certification portals like Coursera, Udemy was also discussed.

The meeting on 29 May 2022 which is supposed to complete at 6:30pm extended till 8:30pm due to the active participation of all the faculty members.

During the Faculty Councill Meeting proceedings, the family members had a good time exploring the nature in the resort. The organizing team organized games and fun activities exclusively for the family members and kids.

On 30 May 2022, early morning Yoga Sessions was organized for Faculty Members. The importance of breathing exercises and simple yet powerful stress relaxation techniques were taught. The session was led by Dr. Nachiketas and one another Certified Yoga Expert in the Resort. After the boating in the Periyar Lake surrounded by the serene western ghats, the rejuvenated faculty members continued their discussions about the institutional long-term plans.

Dr. Balaji & Dr. Goutam, members of the BBA committee, presented the BBA action plan. The team presented the top BBA programmes in Madurai, Chennai & in India and compared the Fees Structure and curriculum of various institutions. Lot of ideas came in on how to position the TSM BBA pogramme. Once we receive the required statutory approvals, the committee is set to launch the high quality and differentiating BBA programme.

Dr. Pradeep, member of University Committee, presented the possibilities of TSM becoming a University. Different options like Deemed-to-be-University (like SRM, VIT), Private State University (like KREA etc) were discussed.

Dr. Nataraj presented the proceedings of the MDP done in the last year 2021-2022. The faculty team was appraised that around Rs.45 lakhs was generated as revenues from the MDPs during the last year. The Faculty Council discussed the possibilities of increasing the MDP revenues, including the PGDDSBA programme, to around One Crore Rupees. The Faculty Team looks forward to Mr. Satish Raman's support in this regard.

Dr. Nachiketas presented the Consultancy proceedings. This area which is in budding stage requires lot of initiatives. Dr. Nachi suggested having templated solutions for generic managerial and business problems. These templates with little customization can be offered as customized solutions to the lot of MSME in and around Madurai.

An open talk session was organized by the Organising Committee, where all the Faculty members spoke on the (not limited to) the following topics:

- What is your most cherished moment(s) at TSM?
- What do you think is TSM's strength?
- What do you think are your significant achievement(s) at TSM?
- Where do you want the TSM to be in 2027?
- How can I contribute to that?

- What kind of support do you require at TSM to achieve your career goal?
- Do you have any regrets? Did you face any challenges?

It is heartening to note that all the Faculty Members want to be a part of the TSM growth journey and are excited to contribute their best. Several games to increase the bonding and cohesion among the faculty members and their family members were organized.

On the last day, all the faculty and family members visited the spice plantation and got to know about the different types of spices.

The team returned to TSM campus fully refreshed, rejuvenated and recharged.
