Training Officer - Job Description: Roles and Responsibilities

1. Training and Development

a. Develop and implement training programs that are aligned with the institutional objectives, including design and development of curriculum, materials, and assessments with focus on successful outcomes.

2. Career guidance and skill enhancement

- a. Identify gap / improvement areas of the students right from 1st trimester.
- b. Work to address the same using aptitude and other interventions.
- c. Conducting need assessment study to understand what students already know and what they need to learn next.
- d. Lead group discussions and providing guidance on effective communication skills and other soft skills.
- e. Development of promotional materials like newsletters, presentations, posters and posting updates on website, social media etc.

3. <u>Industry orientated Training</u>

- a. Arrange mock GD / mock PI to be conducted by industry HR leads.
- b. Train students from interview to complete student lifecycle based on feedback received from companies.
- c. Present training sessions that are engaging and interactive to help students retain information and use it effectively.
- d. Coordinating with internal and external faculty and students to develop and deliver training programmes.

4. Industry centric outcomes

- a. Measure the effectiveness of training programs by conducting evaluations with participants after a course has been completed.
- b. Creating resources to support learning objectives, such as handouts, workbooks, presentations, videos, blogs or podcasts.
- c. Conducting training sessions in person or through online platform.
- d. Identify career needs and devise individual learning plans, training sessions and interactive lectures making students industry ready.

Key Skills

- Minimum 3 years training experience with excellent communication / people skills.
- Possess knowledge on learning methodologies.
