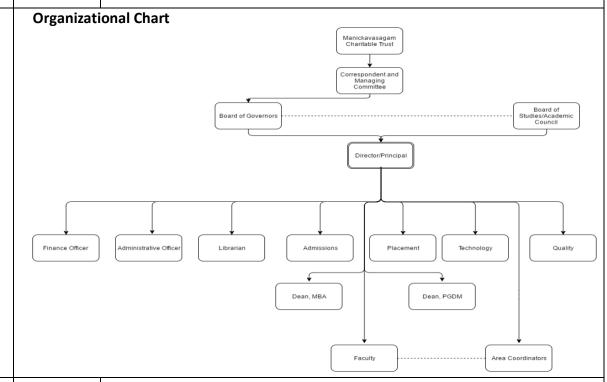

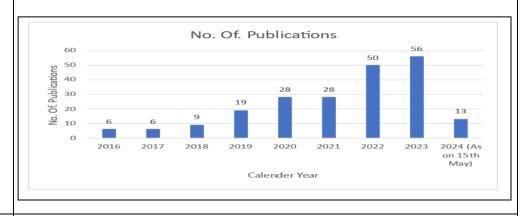

#### 1. ICT INTEGRATED TEACHING LEARNING PROCESS & RESEARCH
