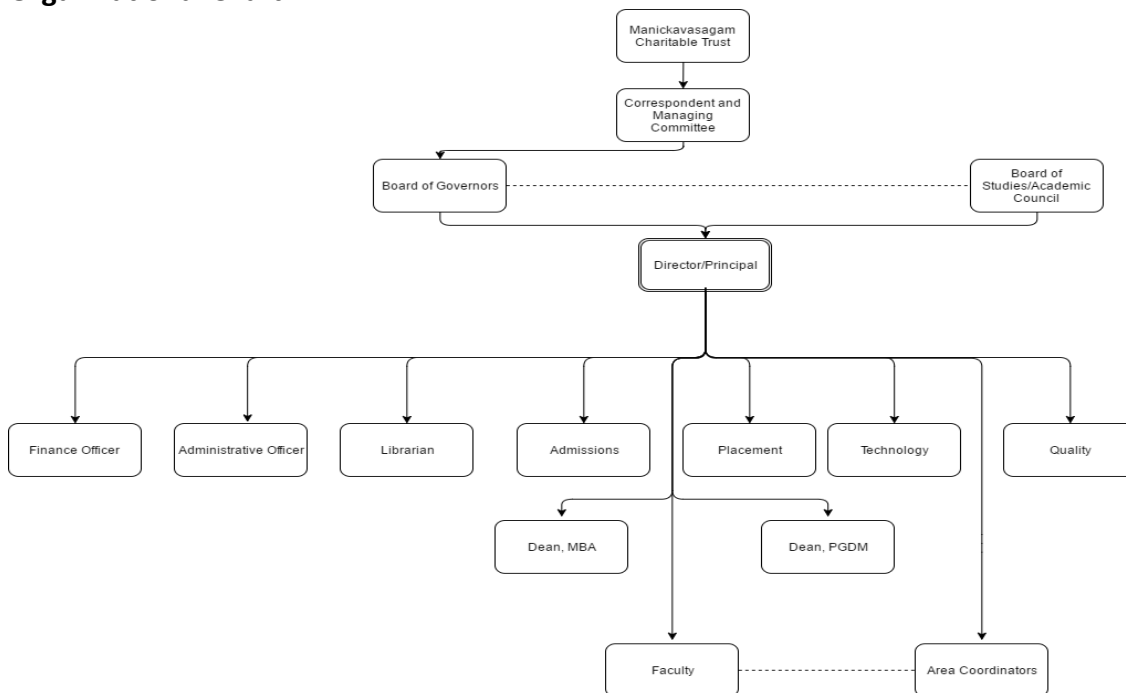

Each student is allocated with faculty mentors during the commencement of the course.
